Laura Hastings announced that the Board would hold a budget meeting on April 9<sup>th</sup> at 8:15PM. Laura also discussed NYS' GAP Elimination Adjustment and how it is affecting our school district. She encouraged all residents to visit the PTA advocacy website to get more information regarding the school district.

**Trustee's Report**

The Village will hold a Budget meeting on March 13<sup>th</sup> at 7:30PM at Village Hall. New technology for the Village is a big focus in the new budget. The Trustees also discussed a proposal to have a setback for parked cars at the intersection of Brompton Road and Cambridge Avenue, so that drivers would have a clearer line of sight. Finally, the Senior Center project will go out for bids in two weeks.
