SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT

The Village of Island Park is establishing a Municipal Parking Permit Fee for the Village of Island Park Volunteer Fire Department Members.

SECTION 2. Addition of Subsection H. Village of Island Park Volunteer Fire Department Membership Parking Permits to Section 5. Permit Fees and Term:

Section H. Village of Island Park Volunteer Fire Department Membership Parking Permits shall be issued as herein described:

1. The fee for an annual Parking Permit for a member of the Village of Island Park Volunteer Fire Department shall be the same fee and requirements as outlined for Residential Parking Permits contained in subsection A of this Section.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY

If a court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court's order or judgement shall not effect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgement or order shall be rendered.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
