## ORDINANCE NO. 101-A

### **DRIVEWAYS**

## Section 1 Permit Required

No person, firm or corporation shall hereafter construct, build, establish or maintain any driveway over, across, or upon any portion of the public sidewalk or public parkway without first having obtained a permit to do so from the Village Clerk.

Application for permit must be made in writing upon forms furnished by the Village. Said application shall contain the name and address of the applicant, the name of the contractor, who is to construct said driveway, and the proposed location and dimensions of such driveway.

# Section 2 Fees

Before work is started, the contractor shall pay to the Village Clerk, permit and inspection fee of \$3.00 for all new driveways constructed and all resurface work of an existing driveway.

### Section 3 Specifications

Driveways shall be constructed in a manner and of a material equal at least to that existing for the paving in the public sidewalk adjacent thereto.

The width of the driveways for residential or dwelling house shall be not less than 9 feet or more than 14 feet at the outer edge of the sidewalk.

### Section 4

Any person or persons violating any provision of this ordinance, or any part thereof, shall be liable for and forfeit and pay a penalty of not less than Ten (\$10.00) Dollars nor more than twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars for each violation thereof, for the use of said Village. Any violation of this ordinance, or any part thereof, shall constitute disorderly conduct and any person violating any provision of this ordinance or any part thereof, shall

be and is hereby declared a disorderly person.

# Section 5

Any driveway hereafter constructed shall be sufficiently graded between the garage or front building line and the street to create a gradual descent. The descent shall be a minimum of one quarter inch (1/4") vertical to one (1") foot horizontal. [Addition enacted April 20, 1961].
