

ORDINANCE NO. 34—H

MAIN ARTERY OF TRAVEL

Section 1

(a) Warwick Road is hereby designated as a main artery of travel at the intersection of Suffolk Road.

(b) Marina Place and Redfield Road are hereby designated as main arteries of travel at the intersection of Waterford Road.

(c) Long Beach Road is hereby designated as a main artery of travel at the intersection at the south end of Nassau Lane.

Section 2

All vehicles approaching any of the aforesaid main arteries of travel from an intersecting street shall, before crossing or turning into the same, come to a full stop, unless otherwise directed by a traffic officer or signal.

Section 3

Conspicuous signs or signals shall be displayed at all points where the rule prescribed by this Ordinance is to be observed.

Section 4

Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance, or any part thereof, shall be liable for and forfeit and pay a penalty of not more than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for each violation thereof for the use of said Village. Any violation of this Ordinance, or any part thereof, shall constitute disorderly conduct, and any person violating any provision of this Ordinance, or any part thereof, shall be and is hereby declared a disorderly person.
