

ORDINANCE NO. 50

EXITS IN THEATRES

Section 1

Each and every exit of every theatre, opera house or other place of amusement within the Village of Island Park, Nassau County, New York, must be designated by a sign stating that it is such, and be number with lettering plainly legible. Each of such exits must have a red light burning above the same at all times when theatre or other place of amusement is in use.

All exit doors shall open outwardly. All exit and passageways, into which they may lead, shall be unobstructed at all times. None of such doors shall be equipped with anything in the nature of a lock, bar, hook, bolt, hasp or catch to prevent access from within at any time when the said theatre or other place of amusement is in use. All exit doors of churches in said Village shall open outwardly.

Section 2

Any person or persons, firm, association or corporation violation any provision of this section, or any part thereof, shall be liable for and forfeit and pay a penalty of not more than fifty (\$50) dollars. Any violation of this ordinance, or any part thereof, shall constitute disorderly conduct and any person violating this section, or any part thereof, shall be and is hereby declared a disorderly person.
