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- 2 requests the standardization of the
- 3 defibrillator systems in the two ambulances;
- 4 and,
- 5 Whereas, standardization will provide
- 6 efficiency of emergency response operations and
- 7 streamline the training requirements;
- Now therefore be it resolved, that the
- 9 defibrillator systems in the two ambulances will
- 10 be standardized to achieve compatibility and
- 11 efficiency of operations.
- 12 MAYOR McGINTY: Motion?
- TRUSTEE GAGLIARDI: I'll make it.
- 14 TRUSTEE NAUDUS: Second.
- 15 (Whereupon, all Board members voted
- 16 affirmatively.)
- 17 MAYOR McGINTY: For the record, we
- 18 agreed that the defibrillator and the inherent
- 19 systems will be the same in both ambulances.
- 20 They're standardized for the efficacy of the
- 21 operation. Madam Clerk.
- MS. CONROY: Whereas, the Village has
- 23 received funding approval for a grant from the
- 24 U.S. Department of Homeland Security Federal
- 25 Emergency Management Agency for operations and



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- 2 safety; and,
- Whereas Physio-Control, Incorporated,
- 4 is the sole source provider in the emergency
- 5 response services market for the LIFEPAK 15
- 6 monitor/defibrillator;
- Now therefore be it resolved that the
- 8 Mayor is authorized to purchase from
- 9 Physio-Control, Incorporated a LIFEPAK 15
- 10 monitor/defibrillator along with ancillary
- 11 support equipment and a four year on-site
- 12 comprehensive maintenance plan for a cost not to
- 13 exceed forty-one thousand eight hundred dollars.
- 14 MAYOR McGINTY: Motion.
- 15 TRUSTEE GAGLIARDI: I'll make it.
- 16 TRUSTEE NAUDUS: Second.
- 17 MAYOR McGINTY: On the motion.
- 18 (Whereupon, all Board members voted
- 19 affirmatively.)
- 20 MAYOR McGINTY: Once again, the
- 21 ancillary equipment associated with the
- 22 Physio-Control defibrillator will be
- 23 standardized for both ambulances for the
- 24 efficacy of effort.
