It is with great pleasure to announce that the Incorporated Village of Island Park's 9/11 Memorial Structure being constructed at the triangle located on Parma Road and Long Beach Road will have "Memorial and Dedicational Bricks" on sale at Village Hall. These Memorial and Dedicational Bricks are in honor of the men, women, and children that were taken from our lives too soon.

September 11<sup>th</sup> was a day that not only affected the lives of residents for New York, but all across the United States. We would like to thank the New York City Police Department, New York City Fire Department, the New York/New Jersey Port Authority, and all First Responders that assisted on September 11<sup>th</sup> and continue to protect us. This tribute is our village's way of showing love, passion, and patriotism for this great country and for the brave men and women of the Armed Forces who protect us each and every day.

The 9/11 memorial features a steel beam from the World Trade Center, which was donated by the New York/New Jersey Port Authority.

Purchasers can pick up the application at Village Hall and provide the information that they would like to have engraved with the name of an individual, family, or business. All applications will be reviewed by the Board of Trustees before being submitted for engraving. All bricks are 4" x 8" and will have 14 characters per line including spaces, 3 lines of copy, "Vermarco" lettering with Black Paint. Unfortunately, the bricks are limited to two per person. You can purchase a brick at Village Hall for \$50.00 per brick, paid by cash or check, made payable to the Incorporated Village of Island Park.
