

VILLAGE OF ISLAND PARK
LOCAL LAW NO. 3 OF 1984

A local law amending Ordinance No. 70

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Island Park as follows:

TAKE NOTICE that the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of Island Park, Nassau County, New York will hold a public hearing on October 18, 1984 at 7:30 p.m. at the Village Hall, 127 Long Beach Road, Island Park, New York to consider the enactment of proposed Local Law #3 of the year 1984 entitled a local lay amending ordinance #70" to read as follows:

First: Section 2 of Ordinance #70 is hereby amended to read as follows:

- a) No person shall be permitted to enter or remain upon said Beach Parks or the pier thereon at about the end of Waterford Road except upon compliance with the provisions of this ordinance.
- b) No person who does not reside in, conduct a business or own property within the Village of Island Park shall fish from the pier extending into Island Park Harbor from September 16th to May 30th each year unless he obtains a permit from the Village.
- c) The fee for such permit shall be \$100 annually.

Second: This local law shall take effect according to law.
