A local law amending Local Law 3 of 1976, Local Law 8 of 1989 and Local Law 1 of 2006

Be it enacted by the BOARD OF TRUSTEES **of the**

of Island Park **as follows:**

Section 1. The use or operation of any mower or power lawn mower or other power equipment by any person or persons, firm, association or corporation other than the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on weekdays and between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on Saturday is prohibited except in the case of an urgent necessity in the interest of public safety and then only with a Permit from the Building Inspector.

Section 2. No person or persons, firm, association or corporation may place or scatter any garbage, refuse, cutting, leaves, wood or other materials upon any public place or private property.

Section 3. Every person convicted of a violation of any provisions of any provisions of this local law shall be punished by and subjected to a fine of not more than \$250.00 for each violation. In addition to the foregoing penalties, it is ordained that any violation of this local law or any provisions thereof, shall constitute disorderly conduct and the person violating the same, shall be and hereby is declared to be a disorderly person.

Section 4. Operation to Comply with certain requirements.

Every landscaper within the Incorporated Village of Island Park shall be required to comply with the following:

A. An annual fee of one hundred dollars (100.00) per vehicle shall be paid to the Village by each commercial landscaper and gardener.

B. Registration shall be renewed no later than March 1st of every year.

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
