SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT

The Village of Island Park is increasing fines for violations.

SECTION 2. Section 7 as Adopted

Section 7.

For every violation of the provisions of this ordinance the general agent, architect, builder, contractor, owner, or tenant or any other person who commits, takes part or assists in any violation of this ordinance, or who maintains any building or premises in which any violation of this ordinance shall exist, shall for each and every violation be imprisoned for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days or, be fined a minimum of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00), or both. Each day

that a violation is permitted to exist after notice to abate such violation shall constitute a separate offense. Any violation of this ordinance or any part thereof shall constitute disorderly conduct and any person violating the same shall be a disorderly person.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY

If a court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court's order or judgement shall not effect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgement or order shall be rendered.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
