### SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT

The Village of Island Park is repealing Ordinance Number 7A, Depositing of Materials on Village Streets, and establishing a local law amending Section 2 Fees.

## **SECTION 2. DEPOSITING OF MATERIALS ON VILLAGE STREETS**

Section 1. No person or persons, firm, association or corporation shall cause or permit any accumulation of sand, gravel, cinders, topsoil, mud, earth, or any other material or substance to be placed, deposited, tracked or flowed or spilled upon any street, road, or highway within the Incorporated Village of Island Park.

Section 2. Any person, violating any provision of this Local Law, or any part thereof, shall be guilty of an offense punishable by a fine of not less than \$250.00 and not exceeding \$1,000.00.

Section 3. This Local Law shall not be construed to prohibit the storing of building materials on any street, road or highway when such materials are stored pursuant to a permit issued by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Island Park.

## **SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY**

If a court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court's order or judgement shall not effect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgement or order shall be rendered.

## **SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE**

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
