## **SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT**

The Village of Island Park is prohibiting parking of commercial vehicles on Village streets overnight.

## SECTION 2. Article III, Section 26 B as Adopted

Section 26 B:

No person shall park a commercial vehicle or a vehicle used for commercial purpose on any street in a residential area from 8:00 PM to 8:00 AM. This shall not include commercial vehicle or a vehicle used for commercial purpose from parking temporarily for the purpose of going to or from an adjoining building, or for the purpose of performing work in the immediate area.

- A. Trucks, buses, tractors, trailers, semitrailers, vans with roof racks and any other type of motor vehicle used for commercial purposes, such as the transportation of goods, wares, people and merchandise, are hereby excluded from the highways owned and maintained by the Village within the Village. Further, no vehicle shall be permitted to display signage of any type advertising goods, services, or wares.
- B. The regulations established in this section shall not be construed to prevent the delivery or pickup of passengers, merchandise or other property and the operation of school buses along the highways from which such vehicles are otherwise excluded.
- C. For the purposes of this section, the terms "truck", "bus", and "tractor" shall have the meanings set forth in Article I of the Vehicle Traffic Law.

## **SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY**

If a court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court's order or judgement shall not effect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgement or order shall be rendered.

#### **SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE**

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
