

ORDINANCE NO. 34-C

ARTERIAL HIGHWAYS AND STOPS REQUIRED THEREON

Section 1

Radcliffe Road is hereby designated by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of Island Park as a main artery of travel at the intersection of Warwick Road, in said Village of Island Park.

Nassau Lane is hereby designated by the Board of Trustees of the incorporated Village of Island Park as a main artery of travel at the intersection of Sagamore Road, in said Village of Island Park.

Section 2

All vehicles approaching any of the aforesaid main arteries of travel from an intersecting street shall, before crossing or turning into the same, come to a full stop, unless otherwise directed by a traffic officer or signal.

Section 3

Conspicuous signs or signals shall be displayed at all points where the rule prescribed by this Ordinance is to be observed.

Section 4

Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance, or any part thereof, shall be liable for and forfeit and pay a penalty of not more than \$25.00 for each violation thereof for the use of said village. Any violation or any part thereof shall constitute disorderly conduct, and any person violating any provision of this Ordinance, or any part thereof, shall be and is hereby declared a disorderly person.
