The Village continued to provide Public Education and Outreach to the community and public employees through information (i.e., Stormwater Brochure, MS4 report and meeting minutes) posted on the Village's website. The Village also actively posted updates on the Village website related to the on-going FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant Program project to improve the storm water drainage system. The drainage study progress is also discussed with the public at monthly Village Board meetings.

Public participation continued to increase during this reporting period as the community observed work crews cleaning the storm drainage system and inventorying the infrastructure as part of the HMGP drainage project. Local newspapers and the Village (through their website, meetings, and word of mouth) spread the word that this long awaited FEMA funded project will improve the drainage system throughout the Village.

The measurable goal of providing written and website MS4 information to the public has been maintained. The HMGP drainage study raised awareness of MS4 drainage issues throughout the Village as the residents witnessed the comprehensive drainage system cleaning and inventorying of all structures and pipes. A grant funded program was implemented throughout the Village to replace trees that were damaged by Hurricane Sandy.

**B. Briefly summarize the observations that indicated the overall effectiveness of this Measurable Goal.**

The Village has noted that MS4 awareness has increased throughout the community due to the information made available to the public on the Village website and at monthly Village Board meetings, in addition to the local press coverage and visible work (storm pipe cleaning and infrastructure inventories) related to the HMGP drainage study project. More residents understand the function of the MS4 program and the importance of protecting storm drains.

The Village of Island Park DPW employees are mindful of suspicious activities that may be illicit discharges into a street, drain, or directly into a waterbody. The Village DPW worked with engineers and drain cleaning contractors during the HMGP drainage system cleaning project throughout the Village. Residuals from the drain cleaning were managed at the DPW Yard. The Village ensured that these activities complied with MS4 requirements and the NYSDEC approved design. Annual MS4 training was provided to Village DPW and other staff on March 1, 2017 including a refresher on illicit discharges (types and scenarios).

**B. Briefly summarize the observations that indicated the overall effectiveness of this Measurable Goal.**

The Village received an anonymous report on March 9, 2017, that a concrete contractor was pumping mud into the street on Lancaster Road. The Village immediately responded and stopped the illicit discharge. All Village outfalls were inspected for dry weather flow during this reporting period; no evidence of illicit discharge was observed during these inspections, indicating the overall effectiveness of the Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination program. In addition, the Village passed Local Law 6 of 2016 establishing penalties up to \$10,000 for MS4 violations and Local Law 10 of 2016 establishing contractor cement truck wash down rules.

This includes reviewing SWPPPs submitted to the Village for construction projects disturbing one acre or more. Enforcement of the law and the issuance of Code Violations is an indicator of the ability/willingness of the Village to comply with Local Law 7.

**B. Briefly summarize the observations that indicated the overall effectiveness of this Measurable Goal.**

The Village of Island Park covers an area of 0.4 square miles with an estimated population of 4,732 residents. Consequently, the availability of large areas of land for development is minimal, so the one acre threshold which triggers the NYSDEC SPDES General Permit for Stormwater Discharges from Construction Activity is not often exceeded. However, Local Law 7 of 2007 and other MS4 laws are in place and part of Code Enforcement in the Village of Island Park.
